



UNDERGRADUATE COLLEGE SOCIAL IMPACT STIPEND APPLICATION

2010-2011 DEADLINES

Applications for the NYU Stern Undergraduate College's Social Impact Stipend program are accepted on a rolling basis. This is a competitive application process and funds may not be available for every project idea that is submitted. Priority consideration will be given to applications submitted by the dates listed below; consideration will be given to applications submitted after these dates if funds remain.

FALL SEMESTER:	OCTOBER 15, 2010
WINTER BREAK:	DECEMBER 3, 2010
SPRING BREAK & SEMESTER:	FEBRUARY 18, 2011
SUMMER BREAK:	MAY 1, 2011

THE PROGRAM

During each semester and break period, the Undergraduate Dean's Office offers a limited number of individual stipend awards to Stern undergraduate students who

- secure an unpaid internship at a nonprofit organization,
- participate in an individual or group volunteer community service project, or
- pursue an idea for a project with an intention to create a positive social impact on their community.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

- are current, matriculated students in the Stern School of Business Undergraduate College at the time of the application deadline and during the entirety of the internship/volunteer project period;
- have arranged for an unpaid internship with a nonprofit organization or have confirmed their participation as a volunteer on a community service project by the application deadline;
- have a demonstrated commitment to community service.

1) SUPERVISOR PROOF OF SERVICE PROJECT AND/OR INTERNSHIP LETTER

Attach a letter (on official letterhead) or e-mail from your project supervisor (with your supervisor's complete contact information) that addresses the following points:

- Verifies the project's time commitment – expected length of service & number of hours per week
- Verifies that this is an unpaid opportunity
- Outlines the scope and responsibilities of the project / internship

2) RESUME

Attach a current resume in MS Word format that includes your work, volunteer, and relevant extracurricular experiences.

3) TRANSCRIPT

Attach an unofficial transcript (from Albert). *Please include your name and N number.*

4) STATEMENT OF SERVICE COMMITMENT, PROJECT DESCRIPTION and EXPECTATIONS

Attach a statement in MS Word format that addresses the following:

- (1) Your prior experience with and commitment to community service.
- (2) A description of your project, i.e., what you will be doing.
- (3) Your project expectations. What do you hope to gain from this experience?

5) EXPENSE DETAIL

Attach a concise breakdown of your estimated expenses. Please include a brief statement about how a stipend award will help you to achieve your goals.

DELIVERABLE and DEBRIEF

If awarded a stipend, you will be required to submit a one-page memo summarizing your experience and your takeaways. You may also be asked to provide periodic updates, meet to debrief on your experience, and/or discuss your experience for a Stern profile.
